Security of data – The ASCGB will handle the data in a secure form and will not distribute it to third parties other than for the reasons outlined without the consent of member(s) or if required to do so by law.

If you collect stamps or covers of the USA, its territories or possessions, the American Stamp Club of Great Britain can help you. We offer friendship, helpful advice, and assistance on all aspects of USA philately. Useful contacts may be established with other collectors sharing your interests.

The Club was founded in London in 1954. Since then our membership has expanded with members throughout the United Kingdom and even in the United States and elsewhere overseas. Unfortunately because of insurance restrictions we cannot extend the benefits of our exchange packets or Library to overseas members.

New members are welcome irrespective of whether they are experienced philatelists, medium or general collectors, or just beginners interested in USA stamps or covers. Members under 18 years old may receive the Packets and use the Library only under the guarantee of an adult.

We publish a journal, **THE MAYFLOWER**, which gives news of the Club's activities, includes a postal auction and articles relating to US stamps and postal history. We have an extensive Library and members can borrow items on payment of return postage. We organise an Annual Convention with our AGM and Competition, usually in late September or early October. Local meetings are sometimes held whenever a group of members can gather. We run a New Issues Service for members to obtain current USA new issues.

Members can also receive our sales packets through which they have the opportunity to expand their collections as well as sell their duplicates or unwanted material. The packets are usually circulated by post, but members residing in the same area are encouraged to pass them by hand for reasons of speed and security. Three separate packets operate to provide for members' individual collecting interests: (1) Stamps; (2) Covers, divided into modern (20<sup>th</sup> century, including First Day Covers and modern postal history), and 19<sup>th</sup> Century covers; (3) Revenues and Back-of-the-Book.

Our Annual Subscription is kept low, currently £10.00 per annum. New members pay an entrance fee (£5.00) plus the subscription covering them until 31 December for that year, those joining after June pay half the subscription. If you would like to join please complete and return the attached form.
